






Marino took the lead, diving in with his mechanical arms to collect plastic and other debris from the seabed, with the help of his assistant, the swift and intelligent David the dolphin.

Clark the crab sorted the waste based on the materials they were made of. Plastic with plastic, glass with glass and metal with metal.


